

GRE Fee Reduction Eligibility

To be eligible to request a GRE fee reduction, an applicant must be:

- Admitted to NIU
- Enrolled college senior at NIU
- Unenrolled college graduate or unenrolled Student-at-Large (SAL) at NIU

Dependent Student

Eligible for a GRE fee reduction if the FAFSA shows a parental contribution of no more than \$1,400 for the senior year.

Independent Student

Eligible for a GRE fee reduction if the FAFSA shows a contribution of no more than \$1,800 for the senior year.

Independent Unenrolled College Graduate or Unenrolled SAL

Eligible for a GRE fee reduction if the FAFSA shows a contribution of no more than \$1,800.

Please Note:

- All applicants must complete the financial aid process at NIU in order to determine an eligible contribution.
- Independent/Dependent status is determined using the FAFSA Federal Methodology.
- Individuals meeting the eligibility requirements will be required to pay 50 percent of the full test fee. The reduced fee is \$70 for the General Test and \$65 for a Subject Test.
- GRE Fee Reductions are not retroactive and they cannot be replaced if lost or stolen.
- ETS offers a limited number of GRE fee reduction vouchers on a first-come, first served, basis. Eligibility for participation in the fee reduction program is limited to one time only. Thereafter, the full test fee will be charged for additional tests for which the candidate registers.
